Governing Roles

Committee Chair & Co-Chair

Staff will consider offering professional development opportunities for individuals who take on these roles. The Co-Chair will assume the role of Chair after a one year term.

Presentation: City of Watsonville Pesticide Application Resolution

Thanks to the advocacy efforts of Hektor, Kathleen, and team with Safe Ag Safe Schools (SASS), Watsonville City Council decided to support a resolution asking Ag Commissioner Juan Hidalgo to advertise when harmful pesticides will be used by growers. The resolution states that growers must request permission from the Ag Commissioner to use hazardous pesticides and that permissions become publicly available. SASS was also influential in pushing the City of Greenfield to request the same public notice from the Monterey County Ag Commissioner. A consensus vote of



the council members via email will be conducted to determine the Council's support for this resolution.
