## Community Health Trust Announces 2023-2024 Grant and Scholarship Recipients

**[Watsonville, California, June 6, 2023]** The Community Health Trust of Pajaro Valley (CHT) recently awarded \$225,000 in grants to 15 local organizations whose work aligns with CHT's Strategic Plan of Building Health Equity and Increasing Wellness in the Pajaro Valley.

The Grants Review Committee of Community Health Trust is pleased to have received 39 applications for the 2023-2024 grant cycle, which resulted in a highly competitive pool of applicants. Ultimately, 15 community-based organizations were selected and awarded \$15,000 for the 2023-2024 fiscal year.

CHT also distributed \$36,000 in scholarships to Pajaro Valley Unified School District for students aspiring to pursue careers in the field of health and human services, including Public Health, Behavioral Health, Clinical Professions, and Environmental Health. A total of 42 students were selected to receive a scholarship on behalf of CHT ranging from \$500 to \$1,000.

"We look forward to seeing the positive impact they will have on our community's health and well-being."
