Summary

The mission of the Community Health Trust of Pajaro Valley (CHT) is to foster a healthy and equitable community for all in Pajaro Valley through leadership in advocacy, collaboration, and wellness. The Veggie Rx program supports this mission by providing weekly produce boxes to residents managing chronic illness through healthy eating.

We are currently seeking responsible, friendly, and dependable volunteers to support Veggie Rx deliveries. Volunteers will transport and deliver fresh produce boxes to clients' homes in a safe and respectful manner. Deliveries are *no-contact drop-offs*, and volunteers must be comfortable using a mobile phone app to complete deliveries.

Deliveries are made in the following counties: Monterey, Santa Cruz & San Benito
 Each box weighs approximately 15 lbs.

Volunteer Responsibilities:

Role	Description	Date
Driver Volunteer	Pick up boxes from our Watsonville site and deliver them to households across listed cities. Must follow all safety protocols and ensure no-contact delivery at each stop. Will use a delivery app to log completed drop-offs.	Tues, Wed, Thurs, Fri

Other Responsibilities

- Communicate any delivery issues or delays to the dispatcher.
- Treat all clients with respect and protect their privacy
- Represent the Community Health Trust positively in the community

Volunteer Requirements:

- Must have a valid driver's license, Vehicle Insurance and access to a reliable vehicle
- Ability to lift ~15 lbs. repeatedly
- Must have a smartphone capable of running the required delivery app
- Willingness to learn, follow directions, and work independently
- Punctuality, dependability, and a respectful attitude

Travel Requirements

This job requires frequent local travel (100%) across the service areas listed above.

Delivery Schedule:



We require volunteers to let us know by Mondays at 1pm if they are available to make deliveries and confirm the day, city, number of deliveries, and time. We encourage you to have a set schedule and “own” a route, however you are not required as we plan the deliveries on a weekly basis and are flexible in how you can support us.

Wednesday (8am-6pm*): San Benito County

Thursday (12pm-6pm*): Santa Cruz, Soquel, Capitola, Monterey South County: Soledad, Gonzales, Greenfield

Friday (8am-5pm*): Watsonville

**Please note that these are the hours of service, they are not shifts so you can complete deliveries at the time that works best for you. If you are available to make deliveries outside these hours, we can try to accommodate that!*
