At the Community Health Trust of Pajaro Valley (CHT), we embrace a comprehensive definition of wellness that includes physical and emotional well-being, not simply the absence of disease or injury. We embrace an integrated approach to healthcare as a Provider, Funder, and Partner.

For more than 25 years, CHT has been a trusted leader in community health advocacy. Our work began in 1998 with the creation of the Diabetes Health Center—a direct response to the overwhelming number of patients arriving at Watsonville Community Hospital with uncontrolled diabetes and related health issues.

Today, our strategic plan builds on this legacy. We are expanding beyond diabetes care to deliver comprehensive, integrated wellness services, transforming the Diabetes Health Center into Centro de Bienestar, a center built to meet the evolving needs of Pajaro Valley families.

Centro de Bienestar will be located at 112 E. Beach St., in the heart of downtown Watsonville. Centro de Bienestar will be part of our Healthy Living & Wellness Campus, alongside partners such as allcove™ Watsonville and Somos Watsonville. The shared campus will bring holistic health services in one convenient location, creating a coordinated model of wellness that supports prevention, connection, and long-term wellbeing.
